Dr. Burke presented to the Board an update on MOCAAT investment funds. The district plans to move some funds from MOSIP to MOCAAT. Some additional funds will move from Goppert to MOCAAT due to MOCAAT offering a higher interest rate.

Dr. Burke explained that per policy DFA a vote was not needed for this move.

Dr. Brennehan and Dr. Boden provided an update on NWEA Winter Data. Each of the building principals presented their data and provided action steps that are being implemented for their building and teachers.

Dr. Brennehan presented to the board the projected Academic calendar for the 26-27 School year. Dr. Brennehan explained that due to the policy in place we will not be able to begin school sooner than 14 days from the 1st Monday in September. This will push our start date back 1 week this year.
